UDOBO PRE-SCHOOL OFFERING: As has been our tradition, we donate our entire Christmas Eve offering to the Udobo School in Durban, South Africa to benefit the children in honor of the birth of Christ. God has been so good to us and we can afford to be generous to the littlest and least in the world. This is a chance to give these children the best start in life so that they can grow to be Godly, healthy and productive members of their community. There is an unnumbered envelope in the hall that you can use for your regular offering, as well. **Make out checks to “Faith UMC.”**

FINANCIAL UPDATE: The people of Faith UMC continue to serve by providing meals to unhoused people in Binn’s Park, training up young people, offering various small groups and Bible Studies, reaching out and welcoming in new members, providing pastoral care to members and the broader community, enabling meaningful worship services, and so much more. Thank you for sharing your time, talent, prayers, service and witness. Thank you for your financial support. We have now received donations to cover all of our local ministry expenses for 2022. **However, as we begin 2023 we have at least \$6,000 in new local expenses in the first two weeks.** Additionally, **we still need \$12,711 to pay our remaining required 2022 Ministry Apportionments** to the United Methodist Church. This includes 1) The World Service Fund which supports the boards, agencies and missional organizations that resource our UMC ministries around the world, 2) The Connectional Ministry Fund which supports our missions, programming, and staff in Eastern Pennsylvania, and 3) The General Church Fund which provides for the operations of the General Conference. **Prayerfully consider if you are able to make a donation toward a strong start to our ministries in this new year. And if you have not submitted a Pledge Card indicating your plans for the year, extra cards are available on the Information Table in the lobby.**

REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTIONS: If you are over 72 and have tax deferred retirement accounts, you could have a portion of your required minimum distribution given as a charitable gift to the church (or other organizations) to avoid paying taxes on those funds. This may benefit you as you finish out 2022 and plan for your tax returns. If you have questions, about different sources of giving to the church, feel free to contact Pastor Jason.
