

COVID PROTOCOLS: Confirmed COVID cases in Lancaster Co. have increased from single digits/day on July 4 to 180 new cases/day. While a high percentage of our congregation is vaccinated, only 48% of the county is. This increases the odds for COVID in our church. Please wear a mask inside the building & throughout the Worship Service (especially as you enter/exit & while singing). At this time, we will NOT turn anyone away because they are not wearing a mask, but simply ask you to consider the needs of those around you who may be at high risk. Families / close friends may sit together with 2 empty seats between groups & using every other row of chairs. Protocols will be adjusted as we analyze new data.
