

THANK YOU for your faithfulness to our ministries—through your prayers, presence, gifts, service and witness. As of July 9, giving and fundraisers for our general ministries has raised \$89,146, with \$95,080 in expenses. That \$6,000 deficit is smaller than it was in May when it was over \$9,000. So, we are making progress. Thankfully, due to generous end of year giving, we carried a surplus into 2024, which has enabled us to pay our expenses and still have funds in our general ministry account (\$17,697). We have also been able to raise \$18,328 toward debt reduction to be used for our mortgage payments on the Fellowship Hall and Education Wing, and that debt reduction account now has \$13,860 to be used for those bills after making our monthly payments throughout the year.

We need to maintain a regular weekly income of \$4,100 per week toward the regular budget and the debt reduction combined in order to meet our expenses without depleting the accounts. We are currently averaging only \$3938 in income, including fundraisers. If you are able to give regularly toward our ministry—or to make a one-time donation—that goes a long way to sustaining the work that we do together to serve our community.
