THANK YOU for your faithful support of our ministries through your prayers, presence, gifts, service and witness. Through April, we have received almost \$55,000 in offerings and fundraising income. So far, our annual expenses have totaled almost \$63,000. We began the year with a healthy balance in our checking account, however, we have had to use over \$8,000 to make up the deficit. Our goal is to have our annual income exceed our expenses so that we don't deplete our accounts. It is normal for the balance to fluctuate as bills come in at different times—as do gifts and some of our biggest fundraisers. However, as we approach the midpoint of the year, we wanted you to be aware of our progress.

We need an average of \$4,200 per week in giving toward the general ministry budget and our mortgage. If you have gotten behind in your regular giving, please consider if you can catch up. If you haven't been a regular giver or have the capacity to make a special donation, please prayerfully consider how you can help to support our ministries.
