FINANCIAL UPDATE: We have a balanced budget as we wrap up summer! As of July 31, we have received \$105,712 in offerings, fundraising proceeds, & special donations. Our expenses were \$106,049. That difference is only -\$337. Thank you for your generosity!! We also have a healthy balance in our checking and savings account for various purposes including capital projects and a reserve for cash flow. Our goal is to finish 2025 with at least the same reserves that we began with. We need an average of \$4,200 per week in giving toward the general ministry budget and our mortgage payments.
